

ORDINANCE NUMBER 266

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 254 SECTION 4; SUBSECTION g, REGARDING PUBLIC BURNING.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hugo, hereinafter referred to as the "Board" and the "Town" respectively, previously adopted Ordinance Number 254 titled "An Ordinance Concerning Nuisances and Providing for Penalties for Violations"; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to amend Section 4; subsection g, of Ordinance Number 254;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTESS FOR THE TOWN OF HUGO, COLORADO:

Section 1. Restatement of Section 4; subsection g; of Ordinance 254 regarding public burning on the adoption of this ordinance shall be restated and amended to state as follows:

g. Public Burning.

1. The burning of woods, leaves, branches, and rubbish within the Town limits is permitted, provided there are no burn restrictions by the Hugo Fire Protection District in place at the time, and
2. Permission has been obtained, by the property owner or agent, from the Fire Chief of the Fire District or his/her appointee for the jurisdiction of the Town of Hugo.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, or clause of this ordinance shall be deemed to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, and clauses shall not be affected thereby.

Section 3. Repealer. All acts, orders, resolutions, ordinances, or parts thereof, of the Town that are inconsistent or in conflict with the ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent only of such inconsistency or conflict.

Section 4. Recording and Authentication. Immediately upon its passage, this ordinance shall be recorded in the Town of Hugo Book of Ordinances kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signatures of the Mayor and Clerk, shall be published as required by law.
