ORDINANCE NUMBER 280

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4 (D) OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 209

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hugo, hereinafter referred to as the "Board" and the "Town", respectively, previously adopted Ordinance Number 209 for the regulation of traffic and to provide penalties and violation thereof;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town, hereinafter referred to as the "Board" wishes to change the language in Section 4 (D).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUGO, COLORADO TO AMEND SECTION 4 (D) TO READ:

SECTION 4 (D):

The municipal Judge is empowered in his or her discretion to assess costs against any defendant who plead guilty or nolo contendere or who enters into a plea agreement of who, after trial, is found guilty of an ordinance violation. In all such cases that the municipal judge assesses costs, the amount of said cost shall be Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00)

SECTION III - VALIDITY.

If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each part or parts thereof, irrespective of the fact that any part or parts be declared invalid.

SECTION III - REPEAL.

Existing or parts of Ordinances covering the same matters as embraced in this Ordinance are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.

SECTION IV - EFFECTIVE PERIOD.

This Ordinance shall published as required by law and shall be filed in the Town Book of Ordinances. The Effective date will be January 1, 2023.
