

Pro and Con Statements Sought on Ballot Issue 2

The Town of Hugo is soliciting written comments for and against ballot issue #2. This will appear on the April 7, 2026 regular election ballot.

Per state statute, comments received will be summarized for the inclusion in the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR) ballot issue notice, which will be mailed to all registered voters. Comments must address the specific ballot issue, indicate whether they are "for" or "against" the issue, and include the submitter's name, signature and the address of where the submitter is registered to vote.

COMPLETE TOWN OF HUGO BALLOT ISSUE #2:

Additional 1% Sales Tax for Culture, Recreation, and Pool Improvements

SHALL THE TOWN OF HUGO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX TO PROVIDE FUNDS PRIMARILY FOR THE REMODEL, REOPENING, CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE TOWN POOL AND TO SUPPORT CULTURE AND RECREATION PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION SUMMER BASEBALL, YOUTH FOOTBALL, PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS, THE MUSEUM, COMMUNITY ROOM, AND HISTORIC DEPOT, AND TO PERMIT THE TOWN BOARD TO USE THESE FUNDS FOR OTHER CULTURE AND RECREATION PURPOSES IF THE POOL IS UNABLE TO OPEN OR REMAIN OPEN, AND SHALL THESE REVENUES CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, AND AN EXCEPTION TO THE REVENUE AND SPENDING LIMITS OF ARTICLE 10, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?

A "YES" VOTE:

- Imposes additional 1% sales and use tax
- Provides a dedicated funding source for the Town pool and other culture and recreation programs.

A "NO" VOTE:

- No change to existing sales and use tax
- No additional funding source for the Town pool and other culture and recreation programs.
