

TOWN OF HUGO BALLOT ISSUE #2:

Additional 1% Sales Tax for Culture, Recreation, and Pool Improvements

SHALL THE TOWN OF HUGO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX TO PROVIDE FUNDS PRIMARILY FOR THE REMODEL, REOPENING, CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE TOWN POOL AND TO SUPPORT CULTURE AND RECREATION PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION SUMMER BASEBALL, YOUTH FOOTBALL, PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS, THE MUSEUM, COMMUNITY ROOM, AND HISTORIC DEPOT, AND TO PERMIT THE TOWN BOARD TO USE THESE FUNDS FOR OTHER CULTURE AND RECREATION PURPOSES IF THE POOL IS UNABLE TO OPEN OR REMAIN OPEN, AND SHALL THESE REVENUES CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, AND AN EXCEPTION TO THE REVENUE AND SPENDING LIMITS OF ARTICLE 10, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?

Summary of Written Comments FOR Ballot Issue #2:

Proponents of Ballot Issue #2 state that a yes vote would demonstrate support for community growth and long-term investment in Hugo, stating that the proposed 1% sales tax would fund pool and recreation programs that contribute to the local economy, enhance property values, and make the Town more attractive to families. Those in favor state that, if passed, Ballot Issue #2 would expand local opportunities for youth activities and sports would provide accessible options for children, strengthen community involvement, and foster local pride, helping keep Hugo competitive with surrounding communities while investing tax dollars locally.
