TOWN OF HUGO BALLOT ISSUE #1:

EXPANSION OF EXISTING SALES AND USE TAX FOR STREET
MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY

WITHOUT CREATING ANY NEW TAX OR INCREASING ANY CURRENT TAXES, SHALL THE EXISTING SALES AND USE TAX, ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED IN 1988 BY VOTER APPROVAL IN ORDINANCE NUMBER 182 TO FINANCE STREET SYSTEM AND STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS, AND MODIFIED IN 2022 TO ALLOW HALF OF THE PROCEEDS COLLECTED AFTER MAY 1, 2022 TO BE PLACED INTO A SALES AND USE TAX FUND, KNOWN AS A CAPITAL ASSET FUND, FOR THOSE PURPOSES, BE FURTHER EXPANDED TO PERMIT USE OF SAID FUNDS FOR ALL ASPECTS OF STREET MAINTENANCE AND SAFETY, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ALLEYS, SNOW PLOWING, AND RELATED IMPROVEMENTS?

TOWN OF HUGO BALLOT ISSUE #2:

ADDITIONAL 1% SALES TAX FOR CULTURE, RECREATION AND POOL
IMPROVEMENTS

SHALL THE TOWN OF HUGO IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL ONE PERCENT (1%) SALES AND USE TAX TO PROVIDE FUNDS PRIMARILY FOR THE REMODEL, REOPENING, CONTINUED MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF THE TOWN POOL AND TO SUPPORT CULTURE AND RECREATION PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION SUMMER BASEBALL, YOUTH FOOTBALL, PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS, THE MUSEUM, COMMUNITY ROOM, AND HISTORIC DEPOT, AND TO PERMIT THE TOWN BOARD TO USE THESE FUNDS FOR OTHER CULTURE AND RECREATION PURPOSES IF THE POOL IS UNABLE TO OPEN OR REMAIN OPEN, AND SHALL THESE REVENUES CONSTITUTE A VOTER-APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE, AND AN EXCEPTION TO THE REVENUE AND SPENDING LIMITS OF ARTICLE 10, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION OR ANY OTHER LAW?

Requests for an application may be made orally by calling the Hugo Town Hall at 719-743-2485 or in writing by mailing a request to: Town of Hugo, P.O. Box 367, Hugo, CO 80821. Applications will be accepted until 12:00 P.M. on Friday, April 3, 2026.

Every person who has attained the age of eighteen years, possessing the following qualifications, shall be entitled to register to vote at the municipal election; (a) Shall be a resident of the Town of Hugo, Colorado; (b) Shall be a citizen of the United States; (c) Shall have resided in the state of Colorado for twenty-two days immediately preceding the election at which he offers to vote.
