

ORDINANCE NO. 225

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN
OF HUGO, LINCOLN COUNTY, COLORADO, TO REPEAL
ORDINANCE NUMBER 109**

Whereas, the Town of Hugo, hereinafter referred to as the "Town", in the County of Hugo, State of Colorado, is the body corporate operating as a statutory town pursuant to the general statutes of the State of Colorado; and

Whereas, Colorado Revised Statutes, Title 31, Article 16, gives to the governing bodies of municipalities the authority to both pass ordinances and repeal ordinances; and

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of the Town, hereinafter referred to as the "Board" has reviewed Ordinance No. 109 which was passed many years ago to deal with the keeping of animals and fowl; and

Whereas, legal counsel for the Town has advised the Town that the ordinance is or may be determined to be unconstitutionally vague or overbroad at this point in time, and the Board has further determined that the matters which Ordinance No. 109 was designed to address are now covered, in large part, by the Town's nuisance ordinance and other ordinances; and

Whereas, the Board has, therefore, determined that the best interests of the citizens of the Town of Hugo would be served by a repeal of Ordinance No. 109,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF
THE TOWN OF HUGO, COLORADO:**

SECTION 1 - REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 109.

Upon adoption of this Ordinance, Ordinance No. 109, shall be repealed, in full.

SECTION 2 – RECORDING AND AUTHENTICATION.

Following adoption, this Ordinance shall be authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and the Town Clerk and shall be recorded in the Town of Hugo book of ordinances. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after publication as required by law.
